TRUST DEED OF ANVARAT SEVA TRUST

THIS DEED OF TRUST is made on this the 25th day of September Two Thousand Seventeen by and between Aditya Ashok Singh, UID No. 6161 9547 3995, S/o Dr. Ashok Singh, residing at Qr. No. 2055, Sector - 6A, Bokaro Steel City, Bokaro - 827006 (Jharkhand), called as SETTLER.

PERMANENT TRUSTEES- Mr. Suresh Kumar, UID No. 9280 9659 3727, S/o Late Rameshwar Prasad, residing at Bye Pass Road, Chas, Bokaro - 827013 (Jharkhand) and Mr. Divya Khare, UID No. 6134 7068 1599, S/o Dipak Prasad Khare, residing at Qr. No. 232, Sector - 3/C, Bokaro Steel City, Bokaro - 827003 (Jharkhand).

WHEREAS the Settlers are desirous of alleviating the suffering and attainment of upliftment of the common masses in the society, they have decided to create a public Charitable Trust and as on this the 03..... Day of Oct..... 2017, set apart the sum Rs. 21,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Thousand only) to be held in trust to begin with for extending humanitarian services including educational, medical, health and/or advancement of any other object and/or any activity of general public utility.

WHEREAS the Settlers shall also be the initial trustees of this Trust and shall utilize the Trust fund including accumulation and accretion thereto and further the purpose hereinafter mentioned and also enlarged the scope and purposes from time to time in public interest as per provisions provided in the Trust.

WHEREAS the Settlers hereby convey, transfer and grant onto the Trustees a sum of Rs. 21,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Thousand only) in cash to the Trustees, the receipts whereof the Trustees do hereby acknowledge and admit TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME INTO THE TRUSTEES absolutely forever subject only to the terms, conditions and obligations contained herein :-

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1. That the Trustees shall as on and from this date stand fully seized and possessed of the same and also other properties that may be acquired in substitution for and addition thereto and all accretions thereto all of which properties, income here from and all accretions, thereto are, hereinafter for the sake of brevity referred to as the TRUST ESTATE upon Trust and for purpose declared and contained.
2. That the Trustees shall be at liberty to accept or receive from time to time, from the Settlers or other individuals, firms, organizations or other bodies whatsoever, any cash or securities or any other property, both movable and immovable (hereinafter called and referred to as the and Additional Trust Fund) as donations, aids or contributions towards the Trust Estate, for the furtherance and fulfillment of the objects of the Trust such terms and conditions as they may, in their absolute discretion, think fit but no inconsistent with the objects of the Trust hereby declared and created and in such event the Trustees hereby declare that they shall hold such additional Trust fund as accretions to the part of the Trust and shall apply the same in furtherance of the objects of the Trust hereby created.
3. NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS UNDER :-
 - i. Name : The name of the Public Charitable Trust hereby established shall always by Anvarat Seva Trust.
 - ii. Office : Office of the Trust shall be at Barkama, Chandankiyari, Bokaro.
 - iii. Financial Year : First Financial Year will end on 31 March 2018. Later on April to March will be Financial Year. The year may be changed as per changes in Income Tax Act.

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iv. Jurisdiction : The jurisdiction of the Trust shall be all over India (Bharat).

v. AIMS and Objects :

The aims and objects for which the Trust is created and for which the Trust fund may be utilized are as follows :-

- (a) The Trustees hereby declare that they and the survivor or other Trustee or Trustees here of for the time being shall hold the said sum of Rs. 21,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Thousand only) made over by the settler to the Trustees as aforesaid and all gifts, contributions, subscriptions, donation bequeath and other moneys or properties as or when the same shall be paid to, acquired by or vested in them.
- (b) The money, investments and properties and all accumulated income from the time being representing the same and which may from time to time from part of the Trust fund for charitable purpose, to apply for the same for the relief of poor.
- (c) To establish, develop, maintain technical and non-technical institutions, schools, colleges, universities, libraries, laboratories, hostels for boys and girls, skill development centres, competition preparation centres, yoga and spiritual centres, sports training centres, vocational training centres, research and other institutions for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge among the public in general.
- (d) To lift public from the sorrows of poverty, poor hygiene, illiteracy and ill health by starting and carry out concentrated and intensive programmes.
- (e) To promote culture and artistic subject/works like drawings, painting, music shows, dramatic performance and dances reflecting/exhibiting Indian culture/traditions. To publish study materials, magazines, books, journals and produce film, T.V. serials, documentaries and audio-video cassettes on burning social, educational and scientific issues.
- (f) To promote such activities as may result in mental and/or physical and/or economical well being of the people of the society in general.
- (g) To acquire and maintain charitable homes/buildings or property, temporary accommodation to persons for the purpose of study, medical treatment and health, Old Age Home, Drug De-addiction centre etc.

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- (h) To open, establish, manage, control and run adult education and vocational institutions in healthy surroundings throughout India.
- (i) To engage teachers, professors, scholars, educationalist of high moral character and conduct who are able to impart efficiently and economically up-to-date education and vocation of students from nursery level to the higher education upto research work in all walks of studies like science, arts, commerce, professional courses, industrial avocations, research works and other pursuits.
- (j) To establish, maintain and run Boarding houses and residential institutions for the students and persons connected with education institutions.
- (k) To carry out all the programs for the relief, rehabilitation, welfare and development of women in destitute, old aged, handicapped, orphans, widows, beggars, sex-workers, schedule castes, schedule tribes, economically backward and other under privileged people.
- (l) To train and equip the pupils so as to be self supporting in an honorable and decent way of life so as to develop into good, healthy and progressive citizens.
- (m) To develop disciplinary conduct and habit to observe the rule of law and self restraint.
- (n) To organize and conduct tours and excursions as a part of curricular of the students as well as educational institution to equip with up to date knowledge in all walks of aforesaid pursuits and develop the incentive and research faculties of the students, teachers and other associated with the establishment under this Trust.
- (o) To pay such stipends and scholarships to the students and research scholars as the Trustees may deem fit considering the income of the Trust estate.
- (p) To encourage, promote or develop alternative system of medicine i.e. Homeopathy, Ayurveda, Yunani, Yoga, Neturopathy, Meditation, Acupressure, Acupuncture etc. Also promote preventive and curative health services.
- (q) To establish, run, manage and control Hospitals, Matri Sadans, Eye Hospital (Netralaya), eye bank, Medical Research Centres anywhere in India for treatment, care and research of chronic disease and gynecological problems, deliveries, etc. particularly for those who cannot think of affording the otherwise expensive treatment of those diseases.

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- (r) To engage doctors, specialist, supervisors, compounders and nurses and other medical and para medical staff necessary for the efficient and proper and functioning of the Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Matri Sadan etc. and also to engage vigil staff if and where necessary for the internal works and management thereof.
- (s) To run, control and manage Seva Bhavan, Rest Houses for providing shelter to the tourists and persons in India for providing them for marriages, functions and meetings etc. and to establish and open new premises, rest houses etc. for attaining such purpose.
- (t) To run ambulance and transportation for the purpose of public service specially in rural areas. To set up, run, control and manage bio-medical waste unit including incinerator and take up other pollution control projects.
- (u) To establish, acquire, maintain skill development work programs.
- (v) To carry out all the programs/projects for the awakening of natural integration, communal harmony, promotion of sports for the physical and mental development of the people in general and youth in particular.
4. That, without prejudice to general powers conferred by the preceding clauses, it is hereby declared that the Trustees shall have the following powers, that is to say :-
- a. To pay all costs, charges and expenses preliminary and incidental to the formation, establishment and registration of the Trust.
- b. To purchase or otherwise acquire for the Trust any property, rights of the privileges which the Trust is authorized to acquire at such prices and generally on such terms and conditions as they may think fit.
- c. To purchase, hire or take on lease or otherwise acquire lands, premises, lands properties, gardens, tanks, farms or any other real estate's or properties for the purpose of Trust on such terms and conditions as may be deemed fit and proper.
- d. To secure that fulfillment of any contract agreement or engagement entered into by the Trust in such manner as they may think fit and proper.

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- e. To institute, conduct, defend, compound or abandon any legal proceedings by or against the Trust or its officers or otherwise concerning the affairs of the Trust and also to compound and allow time for payment or satisfaction of any debts dues and/or any claims or demand by or against the Trust.
- f. To refer any claims or demands by or against the Trust to arbitration and observe and perform the awards.
- g. To make and give valid receipts release and other discharges for money including house rent etc. payable to the Trust and for the claims and demands of the Trust.
- h. To act on behalf of the Trust in all matters relating to the Trust and to determine who shall be entitled to sign on the Trust behalf bills, drafts notes, receipts, acceptances, endorsements, certificates, cheques, releases, contracts and documents.
- i. To invest and deal with any money of the Trust/institutions run by Trust not immediately required for the purpose thereof in or upon such securities and in such manners as provided under the provisions of Income Tax Act as amended from time to time.
- j. From time to time to make, vary and repeal by laws for the regulations of the business of the Trust, its offices and servants.
- k. To delegate all or any the powers hereby conferred upon them to persons or person as they may from time to time think fit.
- l. To appoint qualified auditor for auditing the annual accounts of the Trust and make report thereof.
- m. To do all other acts and deeds which are deemed necessary and proper for the purpose of running the Trust.
- n. That, the Trustees may from time to time, out of the Income of the Trust property, set aside sums as they may think proper as a reserve or reserves, which shall at discretion of the Trustees be applicable for any of the purpose of the Trust hereby created.

5. Trust Property :

The Settlor hereby vests finally and irrevocable a sum of Rs. 21,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Thousand only). The aforesaid sum of Rs. 21,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Thousand only) shall be initial fund of the Trust, any further sum or sums received in the form of money or monies worth by way of donations, gifts and grants or acquired by any other mode by the Trust shall be the property of the Trust. The property of the Trust shall vest in these Trustees only.

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6. Board of Trustees :

- a) The management and control of the Trust and its properties shall vest in the Board of Trustees. Board of Trustees shall comprise of minimum three (3) and maximum eleven (11) Trustees including the settler. The above member shall consist of three Permanent Trustees.
- b) There shall be two categories of Trustees - one "Permanent" as mentioned above and the other "Associate Trustees" who shall be appointed by the Permanent Trustees, if required, for a period of one year. It would be obligatory on the part of permanent trustees to appoint at least one eminent person/social worker and will be treated as associate trustee.
- c) Associate Trustee will hold office for a period of one year or for such lesser period as the Board of Trustees may decide from time to time but shall be eligible for re-appointment in the manner stated in These Presents.
- d) There shall be a Chairman, a General Secretary and a Treasurer for the administration of this trust, nominated by the Board of Trustees, who shall be one among the above mentioned trustees for a period of one year.
- e) That each Permanent Trustee shall contribute minimum a sum of Rs. 21,000/-, in the Trust so that the objective of the Trust can be achieved.
- f) That, no Trustee shall be eligible as a Trustee and he shall cease to be a Trustee, if he became :-
 - " A person of unsound mind.
 - " A person adjudged insolvent and remaining undercharged.
 - " A person convicted for any offence involving moral turpitude.
- g) That, the office of the Trustees shall stand vacated if he -
 - " Dies
 - " Resigns his office
 - " Neglects his duties and/or transfer powers and is, requested by at least three fourth majorities of the Trustees to quit office in the interest of Trust.

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- " Absent himself from four consecutive meeting of the Trustees without obtaining leave of absence.
- h) That, in the event of death or resignation of any of the Trustees, the Board of Trustees shall within a period of two months from the date of such death or resignation, appoint/ elect a new Trustee in the place and stead of the Trustee so dying or resigning.
- i) Any of the Trustees may retire or resign giving one month's notice in writing to the Chair- man or General Secretary of the Trust.
- j) That each 'Permanent Trustee shall nominate his/her successor in advance in concurrence with the remaining two Permanent Trustees'.
- k) Board of Trustees may nominate Managing Trustee(s) who shall be amongst the Associ- ate Trustees for a period of Three (3) years for the smooth functioning of different project(s)/ organization(s).
- l) That, no Trustee shall be entitled to any profit for holding the office of the Trustee, he/she shall be entitled to reimbursement of such expenses as he may have reasonably incurred for the purpose of the Trust or incidental thereto. No part of the corpus of or income from the Trust fund or Trust property shall be used for the personal benefit of the Settlor and/ or the Permanent Trustees and/or Associate Trustees and/or Managing Trustees.
7. The Board of Trustees shall appoint the office bearers of the Trust and shall from time to time define the rights of different office bearers of the Trust.
8. Bank Account :
- a) The Trustees shall open bank account or accounts in the name of Trust in any nationalized Bank which shall be operated by final signatures of the Trustees/Office Bearers. The expen- diture so incurred must be approved and passed in next meeting of Board of Trustees.

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- b) To borrow or raise money from bank or any financial institutions with or without security or on the security of a mortgage, charge or hypothecation or pledge (in the manner prescribed by the regulations and not otherwise) over all or any of the immovable properties belonging to the Society or in any other manner whatsoever.
9. Amendments: The amendment in this Trust deed shall only be affected by two third majorities of the Permanent Trustees.
10. Irrevocable :
This Trust is Irrevocable.
11. Amalgamation: The Trustees may with resolution of the Board of Trustees, amalgamate the Trust with another Charitable Trust or Institution having similar objects with prior permission of the Charity Commissioner/Court/any other law as may be applicable for the time being.
13. Arbitration :
In case of dispute between Trustee/Trustees for any event, work, function, the Board of Trustee of "ANVARAT SEVA TRUST" shall arbitrate the matter by appointing one or more arbitrator for the purpose and he/they shall act within purviews of arbitration act of India and or as prevailing law at that time and the decision so taken shall be binding of every aspect upon Trustee/Trustees as a whole.
14. Dissolution :
In the event of dissolution of winding up of the Trust the assets of the trust remaining on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstance be distributed among the Trustees, but the same shall transferred to other Trust, Society, Association or Institution whose objects are similar to those of this Trust.

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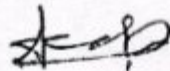
